Appearance : Dark brown, water-like liquid.

HEALTH HAZARD INFORMATION

Health Hazard : Maintain good levels of personal hygiene. Avoid contact with eyes, nose and mouth. Avoid prolonged skin contact, product is acidic.

HEALTH EFFECTS:

Swallowed : Can cause irritation and possible burns to mouth, throat and stomach.

PRECAUTIONS FOR USE

Personal Protection : Maintain good levels of personal hygiene and cleanliness. Always pour product into water and never water into the product. Wear eye protection at all times.

Ventilation : Natural ventilation is usually sufficient. Always ensure adequate air movement by opening doors, windows, etc.

Flammability : Non-flammable.

Storage : Shake container before use. Protect container from physical damage.

SAFE HANDLING INFORMATION

- Spillage : Contain spillage and dilute with plenty of water. Collect with mop and bucket. Large spills can be neutralized with alkali such as soda ash or lime. Adequate ventilation is needed when product is neutralized due to the release of carbon dioxide.
- Disposal : After suitable dilution, as per directions on the container label, pour waste onto lawns, garden beds, etc. Where-ever heavy or poorly drained soils occur.
- Storage/Transport : Protect containers from physical damage. Store in tightly closed, original container in a cool, dry, dark place. Avoid extremes of temperature and prolonged exposure to direct sunlight.
